The grocery store is a key institution within the commodity, often at the center of community and charity events. But it takes an individual who volunteers their time and effort to make a difference.

The individual nominated for the NDGA Community Service Award can be from any level within a grocery organization, as long as he or she volunteers their time to make a difference in the community.

Examples of community service include, but are not limited to:

- Volunteer work on the town board with significant contributions
- Volunteer work at the local food pantry or abuse shelter
- Leader in fundraising for charity or good cause

- Volunteer work at local schools
- Volunteer firefighter or EMT
- A person who makes a difference in your community

Nominate a store owner, colleague, store manager, or any employee that has made a difference in their community.



How to Nominate

To nominate a canidate for the NDGA Community Service, submit addressing all parts of the three points listed on the back of this form.

Selection

The number of awards given in any specific year is at the discretion of the NDGA Board. Directors will review nominations, vote on entries and determine the number of honorees to be recognized.

Recognition

The recipient(s) of the NDGA Community Service Award will be notified July/August 2024. A press release and a surprise media event will be scheduled in advance to announce the award. A sign will be provided to display in the store or office.

Final honorees will be featured in the NDGA Newsletter and on ndgrovers.com.

Honorees will be recognized at the Chairman's Banquet during the Annual NDGA Convention on October 15-16, 2024 at the Delta by Marroitt in Fargo, ND.

Eligibility
